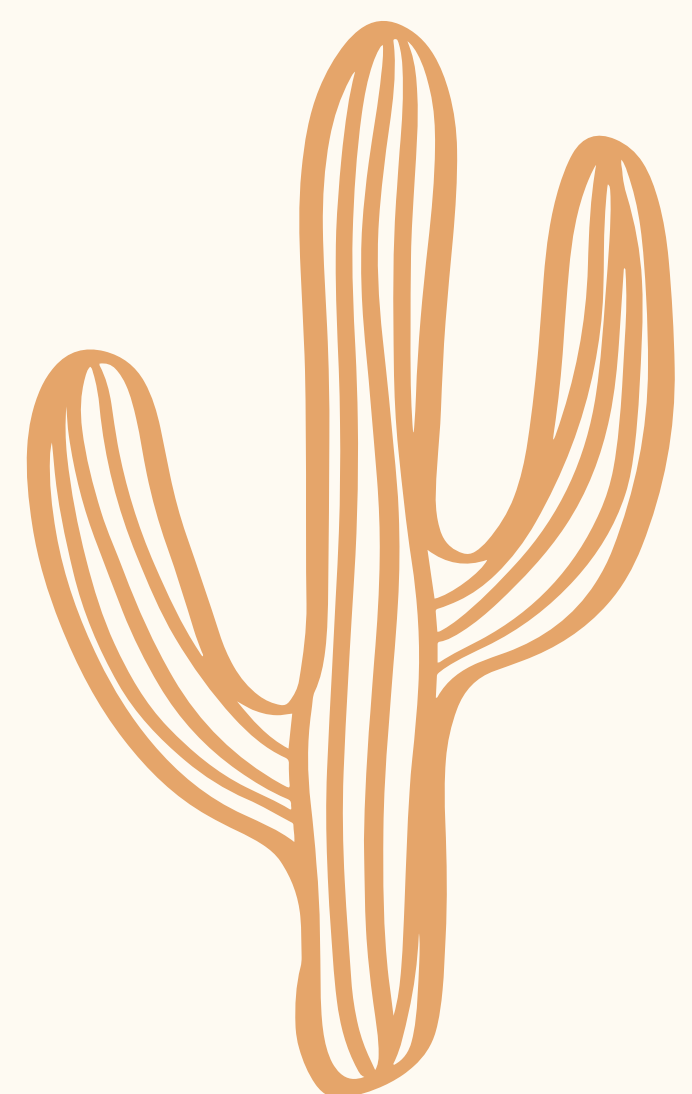

Stubb Stewart State Park

During late spring and summer, Stubb Stewart State Park is the perfect choice for anyone wanting a location that resembles the PNW. There are miles and miles of forest to give you a beautiful green background.



Cooper Mountain Nature Park

- ✦ Wooded areas and Open Feilds
- ✦ Small Bridge
- ✦ Possible Wildlife!
- ✦ Amazing Veiws

Cooper Mountain Nature Park is a similar looking location to Stubb Stewart, but it is right in the heart of Beaverton/South Hillsboro! My favorite feature is that it has the option for more of a wooded background, or an open grassy field.



Asbury County Park

- ✦ One of the nicer parks in Columbia County
- ✦ Beautiful at sunset
- ✦ Not usually busy
- ✦ Good option for sessions with little ones (not a lot of distractions)

Asbury County Park is located in St. Helens and is a gorgeous location for any occasion. There is ample parking, not a lot of walking required, and a few options as far as backdrops. It is located right near the Columbia County Fairgrounds.



Studio Reverie PDX

- ✦ Setup all year round with different scenes
- ✦ \$100 per hour required to book
- ✦ Kid-friendly (bathroom and snacks at studio)

Studio Reverie is my go-to studio! They have seasonal setups that are always so cute, and there are a few different staged background options throughout the studio.

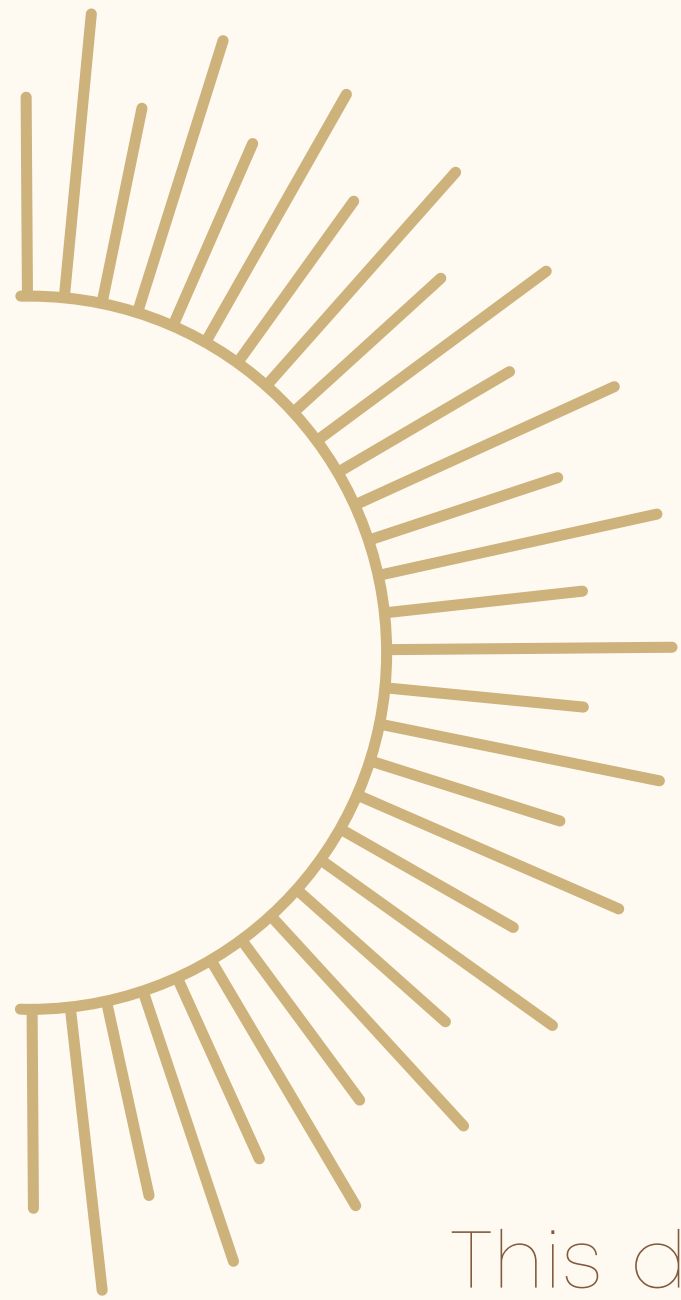

WHAT TIME OF DAY



Why is timing important?

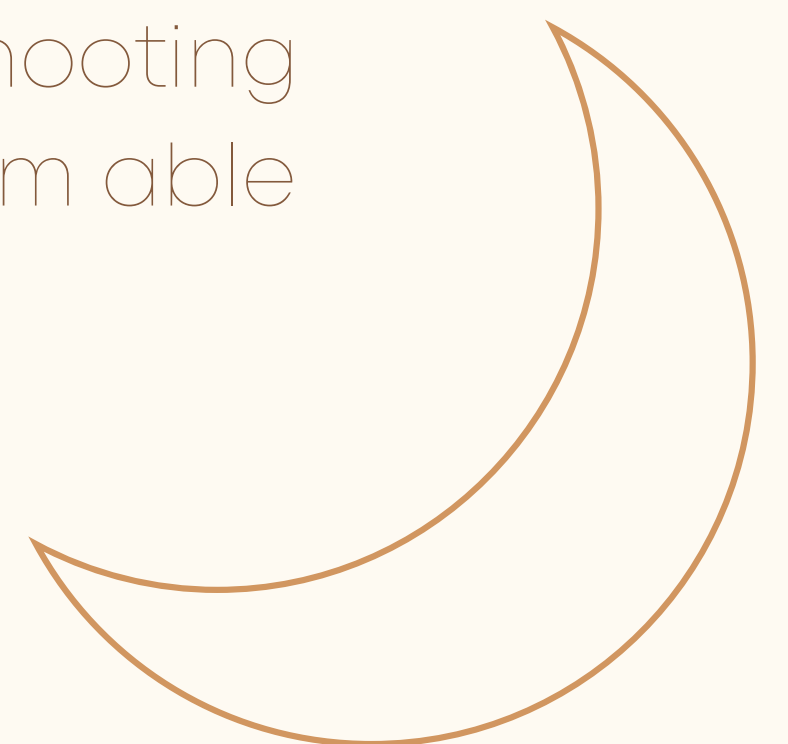
Lighting can make or break your session. The time of day you choose will depend on what you want as far as lighting. For summer months I recommend booking an hour before sunset, or before 9 am. Anything between those times runs the risk of harsh lighting. For winter months, avoid booking too close to sunset, as there will not be enough light for quality photos.

What time for golden hour?

This depends on the season! Here in Oregon, we don't typically get the chance to do a whole lot of golden hour sessions in the winter because of the clouds and fog. I start offering golden hour sessions at the end of May! My golden hour sessions start about an hour before sunset, and the sunset time fluctuates as the months go on. My golden hour pricing will be a bit higher than other times of day, because of how wanted they are.

Can we shoot midday?

Currently I do not offer sessions midday, as that tends to give very harsh highlights on your skin which does not turn out well in pictures. I also do not have a whole lot of experience shooting midday, but look forward to practicing more so that I am able to offer those session times in the future!



FLOWERS!

What are the best months for my favorite flowers?

March - September for Wildflowers

February - March for Cherry blossoms

March - April for Tulips

March - May for Irises and Peonies

May - June for Lupines and Roses

July for Lavender and Sunflowers

August for Dahlias and Sunflowers

September for Sunflowers

Mid July - Mid November for Golden Fields
